Herewith I submit an article entitled: "People-Based Economic Development Transformation In Empowering Micro, Small And Medium Enterprises In South Sulawesi (Makassar City Cases Study)" which has been revised based on input, suggestions, and corrections from reviewers.

Abstract: A sharpening has been carried out to obtain and estimate the tendency of the development of goods and services trade businesses in the city of Makassar in an effort to improve the economy both individually and as a whole as well as the role of small and medium enterprises in the development of the people's economy that can open up employment opportunities adjusted to the research objectives and research methods are carried out by utilizing accurate data from the results of data examination. This study uses the SPSS approach which provides static test results where the three variables (labor absorption, business capital, and business profit) have a positive and significant influence on community welfare (p. 1).

Introduction: A sharpening has been carried out on the substance related to the research urgency that one way that can be done is to encourage the growth of micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs), because this sector absorbs the most labor and encourages increased investment. Then also added literature that supports this research, namely: Mudrajad Kuncoro, in Harian Bisnis Indonesia, which states that MSMEs have proven to be resilient in facing crises and are able to survive because; do not have foreign debt, do not owe much to banks, utilize local inputs, are export-oriented (pp. 1-3).

Literature Review: In the literature in this study, a review has been carried out related to the literature that matches this research study. In the MSME concept section using the approach of Law No. 20 of 2021 concerning MSMEs which can overcome classic problems such as access to capital to financial institutions is starting to be resolved, then supplemented with several concepts from several experts such as: Payne (2008), Michael J. (2000), Ebert and Griffin (2005), and Brian Pratama, (2015). In the Concept of Empowerment of MSMEs, the empowerment dimension to measure the magnitude of the influence of local government empowerment, there are a number of dimensions used to measure empowerment variables, dimensions that can be used as measurement indicators, namely: strength (empowering), protecting (protecting), supporting (supporting), developing (fostering). In addition, it is also equipped with risk management which is a logical and systematic method to identify, analyze, assess, handle, monitor, and communicate the risks inherent in each activity (pp. 3-8)

Research Methodology: Basic sharpening of the use of research methods has been carried out.
