Abstract: A study has been conducted on how ambidextrous organizations can help tourism businesses navigate change and gain competitive advantage over time and unravel opportunities and problems in the era of disruption and examine tactics to achieve a balance between exploitation and exploration in accordance with the objectives of the study, the research method was carried out by utilizing accurate data from the results of data examination with the help of SPSS (Statistical Product and Service Solution), the data was analyzed using multiple linear regression statistical analysis and moderated regression analysis (MRA) which provided static test results where it is important for the tourism sector to achieve a balance between exploration (innovation) and exploitation (efficiency). To achieve organizational success requires a compromise between business turbulence management moderated by adaptability and exploitation-exploration (also known as ambidextrous organizations). To achieve sustainable excellence and navigate difficult times, the tourism industry can benefit greatly from ambidextrous organizations (p. 1).

Introduction: The research has sharpened the substance related to the urgency of the tourism industry's ability to adapt to changing customer demands and new trends while still running smoothly and providing high-quality services. The notion of ambidextrous organization, which is the subject of this research, has great significance as it provides a holistic approach to managing the dynamically changing nature of the market (pp. 1-2).

Literature Review: In the literature in this study, a review has been carried out related to the literature that is suitable for this research study. In the concept of balancing innovation and efficiency where industry shifts are becoming increasingly complex (Kraus, 2021) (Šostar & Ristanovic, 2023), businesses must be able to innovate, operate efficiently, and adapt to changes in the market (Handoyo et al, 2023). Then in the concept of Business Turbulence Navigating the Change, where "turbulence" refers to uncertainty, instability, and rapid changes in the business environment that can impact the company's performance, strategy, and operations (Arici & Gok, 2024) (Murphy & Seriki, 2021). Meanwhile, in the concept of The Relationship of Business Turbulence, Exploration-Exploitation, and Adaptability, the concept of Adaptability is presented, as the ability of an organization to adapt to change, acting as a moderator in this relationship, influencing the extent to which the balance of exploration-exploitation can improve organizational performance (pages 4-5).

Research Methodology: The basic sharpening of the use of research methods has been carried out. This research method is carefully designed in 5 parts; Research Location, Research Approach, Sample Determination Technique, Data Collection Methods, Data Analysis Method. The data collection methods used in this study are: (1). The survey was conducted using a questionnaire instrument to 227 respondents and; (2) Documentation, this study uses various documents related to the situation and conditions of the tourism industry in Makassar.

Results And Discussion: Improvements have been made and it is explained that various factors that influence the tourism industry in the city of Makassar include diverse tourism potential, increasingly better connectivity accompanied by the development of the creative industry. The tourism industry in the city of Makassar has seven types of service businesses, namely: tourist attractions, transportation services, travel, food and beverages, accommodation, MICE, and tour guides. The regression analysis used in this study is Moderated Regression Analysis (MRA). This analysis is used to determine whether the independent variables, namely Organisational Ambidexterity and Turbulence, affect the dependent variable, namely Company Performance with Adaptability as a moderating variable. Moderated regression analysis (MRA) is used to analyze whether the moderating variable can moderate the relationship between the independent variable and the dependent variable. The moderating variable used in this study is the multiplication variable between Organisational Ambidexterity (X1) and Turbulence (X2) with Adaptability (X3)). The multiplication of these variables illustrates how the Adaptability variable (X3) moderates (strengthens or weakens) the relationship between organizational ambidexterity and turbulence as variable X and Organizational Performance as variable Y. The validity test shows that all indicators of all variables studied have significant and valid item-total correlations. Therefore, all indicators in the variables studied are considered valid for use in further analysis.

Conclusion: In the conclusion section, improvements have been made based on the research findings, namely: (1) The secret to a company's success in the market is its ability to manage its operations through innovation, efficiency, and adaptation to changes in the market. (2) Although a significant obstacle, business volatility presents opportunities for growth and development. Businesses that successfully manage innovation and efficiency will be better prepared to face volatility and thrive in the long term. (3) Tourism companies must be able to adapt quickly, use efficiency and innovation, and prioritize sustainability. And (4) organizational agility is an important tactic for gaining sustainable advantage. By implementing this strategy, organizations can achieve long-term advantage, increase innovation, improve company performance, and achieve a balance between exploitation and exploration.
