Your manuscript entitled "Legal Protection of Indigenous Peoples Over Natural Resources and Paradigm Shift of Traditional and Modern Values in South Sulawesi, Indonesia" discusses the forms of state recognition of indigenous peoples and the paradigm shift of traditional to modern indigenous values. This paper presents interesting case study research.

This manuscript has some issues that need to be addressed in order to be published. Below are some recommendations that I hope will help the author.

Introduction

As written now, it is difficult to follow the main message of the introduction. The authors conflate ideas regarding the concept of legal protection of customary law communities according to the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia. I suggest separating the ideas by focusing each paragraph on one idea. In addition, it will create a flow and explain the traditional indigenous people to make changes along with the development of the country.

Methods

Please add the data source and reference year for each dataset used in this research. Qualitative research methods are used to build knowledge through understanding and finding. Considering that this qualitative research aims to understand and interpret various phenomena that exist or occur in reality as a characteristic of qualitative research, in this case, what factors influence state recognition of indigenous peoples and the paradigm shift of traditional customary values to modern customs.

Research Results and Discussion

First of all, the results section contains only the results of the analyses conducted by the authors. Therefore, I strongly recommend removing any information from other studies.

Secondly, table 1, which contains the recognition of Customary Law Areas of South Sulawesi Province, should be simplified and summarised without reducing its substance.

Thirdly, the results section is very long which is related to state recognition of customary law. I suggest keeping only the most important information that answers the formulated research questions. I suggest rewording this section to present the data collected and analysed.

Figure 1 is not readable.

Overall, I recommend shortening the list of citations. Use the ones that are most important and relevant to your study.
