This study aimed to determine the types of ambition and the impact of ambition that affect of the main characters in *Coco* movie script and this study was expected to be used by further writers. In the analysed the data, the writer uses qualitative descriptive research methods through psychological approach. Data is obtained by reading, taking notes and analysis techniques.

The result of this study is the *Coco* movie script by Lee Unkrich contains three types of ambition from Alfred Adler theory there were (1) Ambition on Strive for Success the desire and struggle to achieves success and perfection in achieved dreams which in this study the main character got the ambition to strive for success within himself. (2) Ambition on Aggressive in this aggressive ambition who tended to wanted his dreams not to be disturbed by anyone the main character here very aggressive because he did not wanted to listen his family to became a musician. (3) Ambition on Perfectionist wanted to had a perfect life without any interference from other people the main character had a very perfectionist type about how he achieved his dreams in his own way.

CHAPTER I

One of the literary works that has a structural match with drama is a movie script. This literary work also has a setting, plot, characterization, and theme. The script itself is a story that is described sequentially scene by scene which is equipped with a place or setting, circumstances, dialogue, and often there are characterizations in it. Writing the meaning of the text is arranged systematically in the context of a dramatic structure therefore that it becomes a reference in the

production process. According to Suprapto (2013: 59) a script is an idea or thought that is poured and distributed to readers and contains detailed facts in the wording and sequence of stories or dialogue, the nature of the setting, and the details of the television program. The story of human life in the movie script is developed in the form of dialogue. In addition, the dialogue in the movie script describes the character's fate, character and conflict. Character is usually described by the psychology of the character itself in the form of passion, mentality, ambition, and emotion.

Ambition is a strong desire or commitment to succeed in accomplishing the set goal. If people are passionate and willing to put up the necessary effort, people can have ambition. Aviansyahputra (2019:1). The hope and strong desire that a person has must be achieved to obtain the desired goal. Therefore, this ambition can be seen as a positive thing, but it can also be seen as a bad or negative thing. Because not infrequently, someone who has ambitions can be excessive therefore people do bad things, for example, justify any means to achieve the ambitions and goals people want, therefore that what people do will harm themselves or others around them. Thus, ambition is not always positive, but can also be negative, depending on the context and how one achieves it. Apart from negative ambition, positive ambition will actually be beneficial, both for oneself and for many people. CHAPTER II

LITERATURE REVIEW

In this chapter presents several previous studies related to the writer research with the aim of broadening and deepening the various theories that will be used in this research study. There are several studies related to ambition which are the writer references.

A. Previous Studies

Several thesis have analyzed ambition, there are several studies that previously raised ambition as a research topic.

Ronny (2018) in a thesis entitled *The Reflection of Alfred Adler's Ambition* in *Dean Koontz in Dean Koontz's Novel Silent Corner*. This research aims to find about the ambitious nature of the main character to find her husband's killer, the main character's husband commits suicide by leaving a message that reads. A message that makes the main character confused, moreover her husband is not in a depressed state not is he mentally weak in facing life's challenges. It's clear the main character does not believe it's a suicide. This study discusses the theme of a novel through two approaches, namely intrinsic and extrinsic approaches. The first method used by the writer to analyze through an intrinsic approach includes characterization through direct and indirect methods, plot and setting in the story. The second method of how the writer analyzes that is through an extrinsic approach is the ambition of Alfred Adler. This study discusses the reflection of Alfred Adler's theory of ambition.

Bagas (2018) in a thesis entitled *Nel Abbot's Ambition Cause into Death Murderer Tragedy through Her Character in Paula Hawkins Novel Into The Water*. This study aims to discusses two approaches in applying the subject of literary works, namely internal and external approaches. Through an internal approach, the writer looks for characterizations by telling stories and introducing methods, settings, and plots. In the external approach, the writer seeks ambition by using Alfred Adler's theory. This research explains Nell Abbot's ambition to find the story behind the river in the city of Beckford, she wants to know what really happened in the river, but her ambition leads her to tragedy and this article reveals what conspiracy led Nell to the tragedy.

Aviansyahputra (2019) in a thesis entitled *Ambition of Main Character in Wonder Movie Directed by Stephen Chbosky*. This research aims to examine the types of ambition and the causes of ambition that exist in the main character in this movie, the writer also explains some of the ambitions that are included in the main character, namely there are extrinsic ambitions and intrinsic ambitions. The writer uses a qualitative descriptive method where the writer analyzes it by watching movies repeatedly and using library to research and search the internet for more accurate results.

Moputi and Husain (2019) in a thesis entitled *An Ambition Analysis* Represented by the Main Charachter in Perfume: the Story of A Murderer. This study aims to find ambition in the main character where the main character makes several perfumes and kills 26 victims. In this case, the main character has very high ambitions due to fulfilling his psychogenic needs. The psychogenic needs

experienced by the main character have been analyzed in the need theory of personality by Henry Murray, this study also used qualitative methods and the writer used a psychological approach. The results of the research above are that the main characters have ambitions because there are causes and effects.

Aziz (2020) in a thesis entitled *Children Imagination and Ambition in J.K.*Rowling Novel Harry Potter and Order of Phoenix (2003) and Stacey Bess Movie

Beyond the Blackboard (2011). This study aims to the writer examines this

because the writer finds that there is imagination and ambition that appears in the

main character, where the imagination and ambition that appears in these two

different genres is based on the environment in which the main character

develops. In the literature used by the writer to find data that will be used to

analyze each data such as dialogue, point of view in the story, narrative, plot and

most importantly the main character in the writer research. This study uses the

comparative literature method which discusses the comparisons or similarities that

appear in the selected objects, in this method the writer must choose more than

one object. How to obtain data by reading books, after that the writer uses the

theory of imagination and ambition.

Zuhroh and Hasan (2021) in a thesis entitled *Ambisi Tokoh Novel Politik Tresna Karya Tulus Setiyadi (Kajian Psikologi Kepribadian Ludwig Klages)*. This study aims to looking for ambition, drive and determination that is steady in every character to achieve goals and aspirations in life. Each character to fulfill their desires. Ambition becomes the dominant theme in the novel Politik Tresna by Tulus Setiyad. Almost everything the character has negative goals to achieve his

desires. This study is the goal is to find out the form of ambition and the reasons for its emergence. Applied theory namely Ludwig Klages of personality psychology. This survey includes survey types qualitative descriptive. Research data are words and actions that describe the goals of the characters in the novel. Data analysis techniques through three steps, namely data reduction, presentation of data and conclusions. The result of this study is that there are 4 ambitions in the novel namely selfishness, perfectionism, workaholism and type A personality. The reasons there are two kinds of negative goals, bad states and good states. Every situation there are internal and external factors.

Lestari (2021) in a thesis entitled *The Ambition of Women in Little Women* by Louisa May Alcott. This study aims to find describes the differences that occur in each female character in this novel and looks for the ambitions that exist in each female character based on the lives of women in the 19th century. The writer focuses on the intrinsic and extrinsic elements that build the story. The way the writer analyzes using a genetic structuralism approach and a qualitative descriptive analysis method, the results of this study show three characteristics of ambition, namely the way to be successful, perfectionist, and aggressive.

Siregar, et al., (2022) in a thesis entitled *Anxiety And Depressive Disorders Toward The Main Character In Paula Hawkins' Novel The Girl On The Train*. This study aims to classify and explain the types and causes of anxiety disorders, symptoms and causes of depression, as well as how the main character's defense mechanisms can overcome anxiety and depression disorders. The research method used here is a descriptive method with a psychological approach. The

writer understands the novel, reads it several times, quotes and classifies information related to the research. The results show that the main character has 3 types of anxiety caused by the environment, danger, frustration, sex Rachel also experiences depressive symptoms caused by infertility, infidelity and divorce, job loss and alcohol To deal with her anxiety and depression, Rachel uses three types of defense mechanisms, namely suppression, displacement and rationalization. From the explanation above it can be concluded that anxiety disorders and depression can occur as one of the main causes.

Ikhsan (2022) in a thesis entitled *Ambition in Hans Bauer's Movie Script*Anacondas: The Hunt for the Blood Orchid. This study aims to examine what is the effect of the main character's ambition and to find out what the main character's ambition is. As well as studying the main character and exploring the behavioral characteristics of ambition in the main character. In this study applying the psychological social theory by Endraswara. Psychology and literature relationships indirectly both literature and psychology have the same object namely human life while functional linkage is due psychology and literature both study the psychology of other people the difference is deep in psychology these symptos are real while in literature people are imaginative. And Barsukova's theory for ambition. An ambitious person actively realizes his potential in areas of social activity that are important to people as a rule, it is about professional and career growth, about a place on the professional scale. Success or failure of self-transformation and social situation transformation will determine the importance and recognition of a person by family, colleagues and administration, and in a

wider context the person can gain worldwide recognition and make history.

Ambition as a means of aspiration. The method used in this study is descriptive qualitative.

Anita (2022) in a thesis entitled *The Concept of Revenge and Ambition of* Main Character in Movie Script "Cruella" by Craig Gillespie Term Paper. This study aims to detect the ambition that exists in the main character where the main character has the ambition to become a designer and at the same time wants to take revenge. This writer also uses intrinsic and extrinsic approaches. Through the intrinsic approach the writer applies the concepts taken in the form of characterization, setting and plot. For the extrinsic approach the writer uses the theory of revenge by Matanggaran and the theory of ambition by Tatenhove. Ambition is the energy shown in active action towards an aspiration and goal. Ambition usually acts as a big dream that is easily shaken and arises because of a feeling of not wanting to lose or is born from someone's high competitive spirit, while passion departs from a passion or love. Therefore, the factor of the emergence of one's passion comes from within the individual itself while ambition is caused by extrinsic factors. These two things need to be present in a balanced way moreover that one's goals and dreams can be achieved in a balanced way. Writer used qualitative research methods by collecting data in the form of text from movie scripts for analysis and watching movies that linked several relevant theoretical literature, concepts and definitions as secondary.

Lung, et al., (2022) in a thesis entitled Ambition as Seen in Robert Louis Stevenson's Themaster of Ballantrae: a Winter's Tale. This study aims to reveals how a character named James Durie is able to show ambition and what drives him. Set in the 18th century, the story revolves around two Scottish brothers who develop a lifelong blood feud that turns into blackmail, murder, madness and revenge. Their different views on life, self-control and speech habits also go with it. Emerge through these differences. Way, speech and style. This study uses qualitative research methods. This study also uses the psychological approach and personality theory of Ludwig Klages and Widarso's aspirational support theory to explain and support the ambitious pursuit of a character named James Durie in the novel The Master of Ballantrae: A Winter's Tale. This study shows that James Durie as a character who can fulfill all of his ambition criteria in the form of physiological needs, love, honor, position, wealth and everything he wants must be manifested in such a way that can be seen in human characteristics. Someone who is ambitious for personal gain, this research can conclude that James Durie The Master of Ballantrae is the ambition shown by this novel.

Hasanah (2023) in a thesis entitled *The Analysis of Robinson Crusoe's*Ambition in Daniel Defoe's Robinson Crusoe Novel: Robinson Crusoe, Ambition.

This study aims to about the main character's life goals, journeys, and influences.

The writer is interested in analyzing the goals of the main character in Daniel

Defoe's novel Robinson Crusoe, because the main character of the novel Robinson

Crusoe interprets people in real life and has high goals. A person's ambition can

be influenced by several factors. To know their ambitions, people need to know

themselves. Many writers have tried to express their thoughts about life, one of which is Daniel Defoe in his novel entitled Robinson Crusoe. This thesis focuses on Robinson Crusoe's ambition on a journey, Crusoe guides him to find his purpose in life. The purpose of the writer research is to describe Crusoe's character and the background that made him migrate, as well as to describe Crusoe's experiences. During his journey, Crusoe was able to form life values that made him find his identity and meaning in life as a human being. The writer uses a qualitative descriptive method and uses Karen Horney's theory.

In previous research, this topic is very interesting to analyze and it can be used as a reference for writer and can help broaden the writer insights in conducting this research. In previous research, the writer has similarities and differences with the topic of Miguel Rivera's ambition in the *Coco* movie script which the writer wants to examine. The formulation of this research is to learn about ambition in movie script. The difference is not only from the object but from the problems studied, in this study the writer focuses more on Miguel's ambition which can have a psychological impact on human ambition.

B. Literature

Literature is an expression of human expression in the form of written and oral works in which there are thoughts, opinions, experiences, and feelings of the writer, which are embodied in an imaginative form that mirrors reality. The writer can also convey the contents of his heart, aspirations and feelings to other people, because literature is very based on and has an image of human life and this life is a social reality.

According to Sumardjo & Saini (1997:3) states that literature is an expression of human feelings in which there are experiences, thoughts, feelings, ideas, enthusiasm, special beliefs that can evoke beauty in language. Therefore that literature has elements that can arouse the feelings of writer and readers. Human reasoning abilities are different, people have their own way or comfort in finding out something. There are those who are explicitly told people catch on immediately, there are also those who have to be invited to 'sensate' first and then understand what the substance of something being taught is. Literature definitely has human feeling, meaning it has values or moral messages that can be benefited in real life. Therefore, finding out the meaning of life can be done with literary works.

History books, philosophical works, novels, drama, poetry, prose, literary works which are individual expressions of the writer as well as the personal expression of the writer feelings in the form of feelings in the form of life portraits that make writing look beautiful (Putranto, 2012:12).

It can be concluded from the above literary works that the writer personal expression can be conveyed through feelings, enthusiasm and ideas from works that tell life stories and are conveyed using concrete language. Literary works are also divided into two forms, namely fiction and non-fiction which continue to develop over time. Novels, short stories, and novellas. Non-fiction literary works of scientific writing, theses/thesis/dissertations, journals, biographies, essays, opinions, speeches, textbooks, to books. Literary works are also concluded in the

imaginative results of the writer thoughts which are set forth in beautiful language.

C. Movie Script

1. Definition Movie

Movie is a mass communication medium that is very important to communicate about a reality that occurs in everyday life. According to Effendy (1986; 239) film is defined as an important thing and a means of expression in terms of art as well as enabling communication with each other in a combination of various technologies. Psychological phenomena in the form of stories and images containing words and art music. Therefore, films fall into the category of multidimensional productions. In today's human life, film is very important because it is equal to other media, everything is proportional to human needs for food and clothing. It is said that not all creatures have an advanced culture, while humans still use media as a means that does not need to exist in life, this is something that is not touched by this media.

2. Definition Script

Wiyanto (2002: 31) stated that a script is an essay that contains a story or play. The form of the script is different from the script of a short story or novel. The script does not tell the story directly. The narrative of the story is replaced by the dialogue of the characters. Therefore, the script prioritizes the words or conversations of the characters. From the talks of the characters, the audience can catch and understand the whole story. Script is common writing that is known to

everyone who is in the world of writing. Manuscripts function for various things such as reading materials, as texts that must be read in the world of cinema, contain knowledge. The script is also a story that is described sequentially scene by scene. The text is arranged systematically in the context of a dramatic structure moreover that it becomes a reference in the production process. The script is also equipped with places or settings, dialogues, and there are often character in it.

a). Setting

Setting is an aspect of one of the supporting components in the story. In staging, this setting is an important element because it makes it easier for the audience to know the contents of the performance includes setting of place, setting of time. The setting must be arranged in such a way that the audience can feel the atmosphere when the performance is in progress and can feel the nuances. The scenario writer also describes the setting in detail but also in a simple way therefore as to evoke the reader's imagination (Nurgiyantoro, 2010:216).

b). Dialogue

Dialogue is the most important aspect of a screenplay written by a screenwriter. One of the ways in which this dialogue can help build a character and create an atmosphere, expresses inner thoughts and feelings to create a more complex character that the reader wants to follow. Good dialogue also helps connect the mind between one character and another by showing how the characters interact with each other therefore as to provide insight into each other's personalities and the dynamics of their relationship. According to Hamidah and Angreaningsih (2017) stated, the dialogue in the script tells of conversations

that involve each other's characters that can describe human life. In his life, humans communicate with other human.

c). Character

Character is an inner nature that influences all thoughts, behavior, habits and character of people or other living things. In a literary work, a character is person who plays a role or participates in the events of the story. Character traits are often used as an expression that refers to the character or traits, characteristics or qualities that show how the characters in a story have them. Narrative character refers to a person or actor and actree in a story. Therefore the character that it has, which plays a role or participates in the story. Thanks to the presence of characters, stories can be built according to how the characters and characteristics appear in them. According to Milawasri (2017) stated that, characters in works of fiction also often referred to as characterization, where the existence of characters is very important in literary works because it can liven up the story and bring a good atmosphere to the audience.

D. Ambition

According to Moputi & Husain (2019:12) Ambition is the desire to get what you want wanted. Someone who wants to achieve good goals in his life and his desires that must be fulfilled can lead to ambition in a person. Ambition is a term for someone who has hope or a strong desire to achieve that goal. Many people are ambitious in good terms but not a few are not good. Usually someone who has bad ambitions will justify any means to obtain that goal, which behavior will harm themselves and others. Ambitious is a positive quality, especially for

people who are trying to develop a sense of their own will to achieve their goals. As you are naturally driven to set goals and achieve them, you are more likely to succeed than those who do not. Thus in some extreme ambitious cases, it may end up with more losses than successes. Therefore it would be nice, ambitious is done within reasonable limits. On the other hand, people without ambition and without dreams and visions, no clear direction or intention. Ambition is divided into 2 types, namely:

a). Extrinsic Ambition

Ambition can be extrinsic ambition like a musician motivated by rewards like fame and money. Jobs that people with external goals are driven by desire and success, which is determined by whether or not something is achieved. And the charts that want to go up, money and the lure and fame. Their aspirations drive their work and their success is determined by whether or not they achieve them. External targets see what happens before people see the patterns and paths to follow therefore people too can succeed. People entered the system. Systems create their success. But the system often rewards irregularities. Those who neglect external glory to be themselves desire to push the boundaries of possibility.

b). Instrinsic Ambition

This ambition is driven by the desire to create what people want to create, and their success is determined solely by their own abilities or motivation. Goals do not depend on other people/factors to validate or determine their success. For

example, a musician who focuses on goals that are meaningful to them as individuals. Ambition is the pursuit of success, achievement and innovation to bring thoughts and actions in a positive direction and not harm others.

Ambition will differ from person to person. Some may want to be social workers, while others will be into arts and crafts. It all depends on a person's choices and interests of what people want to be in life, when people reach a certain stage. Almost every individual must have ambitions in his life. Ambition leads us to definite goals in life, which will allow us to focus more and help us to strive towards the goals people have within ourselves. Ambition is very important in one's life. Having ambition alone is not enough. One must also work hard to achieve ambitions, different people have different ambitions.

Ambition can be positive or negative. It depends on how one achieves his ambition. Negative ambition when someone who has certain ambitions wants to achieve their ambitions quickly without considering whether their ambitions can harm others. Ambition is positive when goals are good for yourself and for others. Something that someone hopes to do or achieve. Adler (1927:37), human ambition has existed in a weak bodily condition. This condition of weakness creates feelings of inferiority and feelings of weakness or inadequacy. Conditions like this make individuals aware of their existence against feelings of inferiority role in the surrounding environment.

Ambition can have beneficial or detrimental effects on anyone. Ambition that benefits the individual benefits because it helps people who pay attention to the situation and does not harm others to achieve their goals. Ambitious traits

usually have a better chance of success. This was of course due to each person's passion and determination. People try to achieve their goals, people succeed or fail. It is something that has both good and bad effects. When people are successful, people are happy. On the other hand, if someone struggles to reach their goal, people should try again or come up with another plan to achieve their goal.

However, if people that have ambition is a failure again to reach their ambition, people will face a big problem in their life which drivers them to become jealous and uncontrollable. According to Hirschi & Spurk (2021) says ambition has long been of interest to philosophers because it has become something that can bring individuals to achieve personal and significant needs. Ambition is also a bad trait that can cause suffering to other people in the world and this can be pursued, personal gain. Ambition drives certain individuals out of control, causes people to lose their heads and makes them choose the wrong path to achieve their goals. It would be dangerous for them or others around them if people reach their goal. Therefore, failed ambition has a negative effect on an individual depending on the ambition of the individual.

People has a life goal that has universal meaning, namely a strong desire to achieve something. Humans are born with a weak body. Such a helpless state creates a feeling of inferiority. When people are aware of their existence, people feel inferior to their role in the environment. From all the explanations above, the writer can conclude that an ambitious person can achieve his goals or not. People who can achieve their goals feel satisfied.

A related theory of ambition Adler (1927:35) in his book entitled Understanding Life: The Science of Living, England categorized ambition into three types, namely:

a). Ambition on Strive For Success

The principle of behavior proposed by Adler (1927:35) is the desire and struggle to achieve success and perfection in achieving dreams. Individuals with this character will initially be weak and always think about opportunities to be successful in the future and form a deep sense of superiority within themselves. Individuals will be considered to have a good soul and will fight for their goals by thinking that the ambition within the individual can develop and take action for life's needs. Therefore, individuals who have an ambitious nature can fight for personal success.

b). Ambition on Aggressive

Adler (1927:35) stated in his theory that a person's goal in life is to be tougher and stronger to be around just to do the things one wants to do. Aggressive ambition is an attempt to be the best because of the desire to do something like achieving a dream.

c). Ambition on Perfectionist

Individuals who have perfectionist ambitions have a goal of achieving perfection in their lives to achieve success. It can be concluded from this individual that the desire to achieve perfectionist ambition was born from the circumstances of achieving perfection in his life. In this case, an ambitious

perfectionist individual is an individual who does not want things that only other people can do, therefore this individual will try to fulfill his dream of achieving perfection in his life. These principles are a theory put forward by Adler (1927:35) in describing a person's personality in the perfection of ambition that occurs in an individual's life, including the way people behave in achieving their dreams.

In the nature of ambition there is grit and perseverance that can be taken from the positive impact of ambition. A related theory of impact ambition namely the theory of Barsukova (1997:19) revealed that human belief in his ability to organize and carry out the activities needed to complete certain tasks with this human being can achieve success and can achieve the dreams that you want to achieve. Barsukova the impact of ambition categorized into 3 types, namely:

a). Ambition based on Confidence

This type when indidual like what people do, individuals who have this type can apply themselves with confidence and enthusiasm. Excited people feel confidence whenever people do an activity they enjoy. With that spirit, people became even more excited and enthusiastic. The feeling arises by itself, without the need for outside support and it is easy to finish what one started. Even if there are obstacles or challenges, people quickly finds solutions to overcome them.

b). Ambition based on Personal Interest

Individuals of this type have ambitions and personal interests that what they have done and experienced will produce good and optimal results. selfinterest is a form of persistence that continues to grow.

c). Ambition based on Strong Desire

This type in Barsukova (1997:19) has big dreams and a strong determination to achieve them. With a strong desire, the individual begins to pursue this "opportunity". But sometimes it does not go easy, individual need to fail many times. But individuals with this type continue to try and learn from the failures they experience therefore that in the end with strong determination and continuing to rise from the failures they have experienced they will be able to achieve their dreams with strong desire.

E. Psychology of Literature

Research on psychology theory is useful in presenting various questions in the study of mental disorders. According to Husna (2018) stated that, psychology is the science of psychology that presents dynamics, psychological factors that also determine human behavior the importance of childhood experiences in design future personality. Individuals experience a certain level of resistance, people will react and display behaviors that may consist of withdrawal or aggression, similar to psychoanalytic theory.

Psychology in literature is a fact that proves psychology can be used in literary studies because it is used as a study of humans which can be widely used to understand the character in humans contained in literary works. Currently, literature is not only classified as literature short stories, prose, plays or poetry. Literature to study psychological perspective that can be used in literature as a psychology study. According to Setiawan (2018) stated that, psychology in

literature is the aspect of understanding the human psychology contained in a literary work, therefore that psychology in literature is attached to the characters in literature.

According to Nugraha (2011) stated that, psychology is the science of human behavior related to literature. The writer uses creativity, taste and will in his work. Responding to the work, readers also do not differ in psychology from each other. Literary psychology also recognizes literary works as psychological reflections. The writer captures the symptoms of the soul and then processes them into a text and completes it with his own psychology. The writer own experiences and life experiences are projected imaginatively into literary texts. Psychology is concerned with literary works and dealing with events in life that occur within a person. Seeing and knowing people deeper and further requires literary psychology.

The development of interdisciplinary literary studies links literature with several other disciplines, such as psychology, sociology, anthropology and history. This encounter gave birth to various approaches to literary studies, including psychology of literature, sociology of literature, anthropology of literature, feminist literature, and new historicism. In addition, it gave birth to various theoretical frameworks that emerged from the relationship between literature and its various scientific disciplines, such as psychoanalysis/literary psychology, psychology of writers, psychology of readers, sociology of writers, sociology of readers, sociology of literature, and others, also genetic structuralism, Marxist sociology of literature. From the initial description, it is clear that the

psychology of literature emerged from a type of literary science which involves the reading and interpretation of literary works, the writer of literary works and their readers use different psychological concepts and theoretical frameworks.

Before starting to explain what literary psychology is, it is first necessary to understand the relationship between literary psychology and where these two disciplines meet therefore as to give birth to an approach or type of literary criticism known as literary psychology. Before explaining the relationship between psychology and literature that gave rise to the psychological approach to literature, let us first explain the meaning and branches of psychology. Walgito (2004:10) in his book Introduction to General Psychology states that psychology is a science that examines and investigates behavior or activities that are considered as manifestations of one's mental life.

F. Synopsis of Coco script



But his determination grows, he tries to meet his idol, the friendly spirit de la Cruz and with the help of Hector to find de la Cruz, but he also has to race. against time. and return to the Land of the Living before time runs out. Directed by director Lee Unkrich, *Coco* presents the uniqueness of Mexican culture in a package suitable for both children and adults.. In the movie, *dead people* who are presented as skeletons are given an artistic effect that makes them comedic. While still alive, the skull is dressed in human clothing, which is also decorated with colorful

De los Muertos makes the Day of the Dead no longer a moment of sadness, but one of joy and celebration. During the memorial service, families usually visit the graves and bring offerings such as flowers, candles and food for the deceased. Festival activities include cleaning and decorating graves, such as putting toys on children's graves, adult graves can be decorated with ornaments and bottles of alcohol (Aldo, 2018).

CHAPTER III

METHODOLOGY

In this chapter describe several method findings in the form of types of research, search data, procedures of collecting data and the methods used by the writer to analyze data.

A. Types of Research

This study used descriptive qualitative method. Qualitative methods are analytical techniques used to explore or are more focused on understanding a problem and taking into account social situations. Mukhtar & Pd (2013:10) descriptive qualitative approach is used as the method writer can immediately find information or research theory safe. The type of research used in this research is descriptive research, whose purpose is to make a systematic factual picture or picture and careful consideration of the facts, nature, and relationships between the phenomena studied.

B. Sources of Data

This study uses the movie script *Coco* produced by Pixar Animation Studios and released by Walt Disney Pictures in 2017 for 114 pages. The movie is directed Adrian Molina written by Lee Unkrich. This movie has a unique family theme and is full of surprises, *Coco* has successfully won high income and won an Oscar and was a success at the Box Office. The data uses in the form of a movie script that shows the ambition and impacts of ambition of the main character. The

writer collect data by looking for sources from the literature in the form of journals, books, articles the same approach or method based on previous studies and other matters related to and supporting this research.

C. Method of Collecting Data

To write down the research, the data procedures collected from Lee Unkrich movie script process begins with:

- 1. First, reads the movie script repeatedly and thoroughly in understanding the contents of the movie script and reads various research sources from journals, books, and the last is articles related to the research.
- 2. After that, uses the technique of taking note and collecting data regarding ambition in the character of Miguel Rivera, this technique is used to support subsequent research read the whole story from the movie script.
- 3. Then, selects data and searches for data carefully related to the research problems. After that the data that has been noted and read, taken and selected data relating to research problems.
- 4. Furthermore, finished searching for data, then the writer processes the data that has been obtained and selected according to theory that will be used .
- Finally, draws conclusions data that has been taken and selected and then concluded based on the results data that has been found.

D. Method of Analyzing Data

The data were analysed uses a qualitative descriptive method where this step can help to carry out the relevant research process and makes a list of data regarding the types of ambition and impacts ambition of the Miguel Rivera in the *Coco* movie script. The research data would be analyze through the main character's types ambition by using Alfred Adler (1927) theory the emergence of ambition on strive for success, ambition on aggressive, perfectionist and the impacts ambition by Barsukova (1997) emergence of ambition based on confidence, personal interest, strong desire.



CHAPTER IV

FINDINGS AND DISSCUSSION

In this chapter the writer presented the findings and discussion of the study on types of ambition, and the impacts positive ambition of main character that affect ambition in *Coco* movie script.

A. Finding

This part presented the types ambition by the main character named Miguel Rivera in the movie script *Coco* and how the impacts of the Miguel Rivera ambition. The writer found that there were 3 types of ambition used by the main characters, namely ambition on strive for success, ambition on aggressive, ambition on perfectionist.

1. Types of Ambition of Miguel Rivera in Coco Movie Script.

Based on a related theory of types ambition, namely the theory of Adler (1927:35) stated that humans are weak social creatures. Every human being has ambition, this ambition connects people with other human beings who have ambitions, participate in social cooperation and place social welfare. Adler categorized ambition into 3 types, namely: *Ambition on Strive for Success, Ambition on Aggressive, Ambition on Perfectionist.* The theory above presented in the table below.

a) Ambition on Strive for Success

Ambition on strive for success leads to individuals who struggle to achieved their dreams with very big ambitions and it requires effort to fight hard to make it happen. Ambition strove for success to help individuals succeed in the field wanted to achieved.

His dream to become a very big famous musician, because according to him being a musician not just fun or a hobby but a form of striving for success in one's life.

Data 2 in the ambition data in the table above, sentence *like him* the writer found that Miguel a 12 year old boy who still wanted to determine his identity would see a role model as someone who could be a role model in life like his idol Ernesto de la Cruz, a famous musician in Mexico. As a result, everything about the idol always fun for Miguel. He seen the persistence of his idol throughout his career. This really motivated him as a fan to be able to emulate the struggles of the idol. However, to achieve something, a process definitely needed because of that he always wanted to be like his idol reached his dream and strove to be successful.

Data 3 in the ambition data in the table above, sentence *I have to sing* the writer found that music really affected Miguel's emotional according to him, music had become one with his body. He could not be separated from music. In fact, he always dreamed of becoming a famous musician in Mexico. It clear that sung has a strong influence on the psychological state of humans, Miguel a teenager who had loved music since he was small and even his family never listened to music but not with him. According to him, his emotional intelligence more developed and more controllable when playing music. Because music could help to vent or express his heart.

Data 4 in the ambition data in the table above, sentence *faith in my dream*. the writer found that becoming a famous musician often a struggle. There still many who thought being a musician would not had a good future like the thoughts of the Rivera family. That reason often made his family disagree when he played music. Miguel just considered a waste of time. But Miguel still believed in his

dream and made it came true without thinking about other people or his own family.

He also wanted to prove to his family that his dream not just a fantasy. Because of that, Miguel's ambition to fight for success could be seen.

Data 7 in the ambition data in the table above, sentence *music is my language* the writer found that the sentence above described if according to Miguel music not just a dream that he must achieved but music also a place to express thoughts and feelings and had a direct power that could touch his listeners

music everything for Miguel and language both of them. That's why this went into strove for success in Miguel Rivera.

b). Ambition on Aggressive

Ambition on Aggressive closely related to the feeling of wanted to succeed and do anything as long as it could make him achieved his dream.

idol that's why the struggle for success in Miguel was so strong 12 year old boy rarely had the ambition to be successful in ordered to get the moment to became a famous musician and in data 3 Miguel felt that music not only was it in him but the music is him, everything has became one in his body. In data 4 he wanted to believed in his dream when there a moment in front of his eyes he had to achieved not waste it that's why fighting for success very high for boys who were still 12 years old.

In table 2 the writer found **18 data of ambition on aggressive** from pages 35 to 36 below the writer would explained some of the aggressive ambition. Miguel had an aggressive nature that always wanted to do what he wanted to achieved without thinking much in data 8 it can be seen that Miguel did not wanted to followed the rules in his family and even he did not care that his ancestors in his family would be furious if they know that Miguel has grew into a very aggressive child because in his opinion following his heart is more important than following any restrictions in his family and in data 13 it could be seen that he was very angry with his family and even did not hesitate to said word that shocked his family deeply he did not care about ofrendas ancestors in the ofrenda family a symbol of welcoming the spirits of family members which came to Earth and the main characteristic of Día de los Muertos celebrations in Mexico. In data 18 he shouted at his family by said that they already had their own dreams and they all managed to fulfill them while he could not achieved his dreams, according to him that was very unfair to him.

In table 3 the writer found **6 data of ambition on perfectionist** from pages 43 below the writer would explained that Miguel wanted a very perfect life he did not wanted to miss a moment about music on data 27 he had the opportunity to show his talent in music he felt that if he did not performed and capture this very precious moment how could he called himself a famous musician and on data 29 success would not came just like that he had to fight to get it on data 31 because he was a perfectionist in doing what he wanted he worked very hard to get his dreams for his future.

It could be concluded that in the data the dominant types of ambition was Miguel who easily ambition on aggressive. In this study, Miguel Rivera was considered a child who was easily angered because his action and responded show where he was chased his dream to became a famous musician. He tried to appeared even dared to do anything and contradicted his family. He even dared to do thing that were forbidden by his family because according to him children did not always had to listen to what their family said. When it came to future dreams, according to Miguel he could argue at any time because it was for his own good. Miguel also came from a family that hated music even though Mexico is a country that loved music but he had always kept his dream of became a singer covered up because of his family and all this time he had lied to his family to kept liked being a shoemaker. Miguel took this action because his family firmly believed that played music was a curse for his family but he was always determined to proved that being a musician not always a cursed.

2. Impacts of Ambition of Miguel Rivera in Coco movie script

The writer found **21 data** of three impacts of ambition of Miguel Rivera in *Coco* movie script based on Barsukova. According to the data finding that had mentioned on table 4 page 46 the writer found **8 data of ambition based on confidence.** Based on data 1 to 8 that Miguel had ambition he confident in himself he not afraid to fail in doing whatever it took to achieved his dream in data 32 he was very confident in his dream because his idol in the past would not even anyone and everyone did not know him, but of his self-confidence in the end he became a very famous person that was why Miguel very confident in his dreams and in data 33 he felt that his idol and him were connected because they had the same talented and liked his self-confidence very high. Data 37 he really believed that if he came to his idols singing festival he would be an honored guest.

Table 5 the writer found 5 data of ambition based on personal interest from pages 51 below the writer would explained he had a personal interest in his dreams in data 41 he felt listening to music made him better when he had problems with his family only music could made him better and in data 42 only music could made him happy even though most people chose family to be their solaced but not Miguel who felt that his family not the first option for him to be happy. Data 44 referred to his personal attraction. Music seemed to be everything for Miguel even though his family hated it but he did not made him gave up his dream just like that.

The writer found **5 data of ambition based on strong desire** from pages 53 below the writer would explained the strong desire within Miguel was very strong at data 45 even though he should not like music but that was not his fault

because he destined to be a singer and data 47 it could be seen that Miguel had a strong desire to became a singer data 49 had extraordinary talent how did everyone not wanted to hear his voice he wanted very strongly to achieved his dream.

Adler's theory concluded that ambition was difficult to lost from oneself, ambition was based on aggressiveness. Because A child changed emotion could usually caused his personality to changed quickly over time and periodically also every year. Therefore based on the Barsukova theory the separated impacts of ambition that affected psychological properties but this could solved the problem in ambition that reflected in children aged 12 years old.

Based on the discussion above, the resulted of the research that had been obtained by the writer in the form of types ambition could be dominated by aggressive this very involved very much about ambition but the impacts that affected Miguel ambition would be an ambition of confidence because it could solved problems in the ambition that in Miguel. Between aggressiveness and confidence are separated issues that could balanced Miguel ambitions.

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the finding and discussion above in this chapter it could be concluded that in *Coco* movie script there were three types of ambition and the impacts of ambition on Miguel. The writer used Adler theory of types of ambition to answer the question of what types of ambition were connected and to answer the two writer questions used Barsukova theory of the impacts of ambition that occurred in Miguel Rivera.

There three types of ambition by the theory of Adler namely (1) Ambition on Strive for Success the desire and struggle to achieves success and perfection in achieved dreams which in this study the main character got the ambition to strive for success within himself. (2) Ambition on Aggressive in this aggressive ambition who tended to wanted his dreams not to be disturbed by anyone the main character here very aggressive because he did not wanted to listen his family to became a musician. (3) Ambition on Perfectionist wanted to had a perfect life without any interference from other people the main character had a very perfectionist type about how he achieved his dreams in his own way.

There three impacts ambition according to Barsukova theory, namely (1)

Ambition based on Confidence was a form that tends to had a strong level of ambition with confidenced to do what he wanted to achieved, the main character had a strong sense of confidence to achieved his dreams in this ambition impacts

he became more confident. (2) Ambition based on Personal Interest was a form had a personal interest in something he wanted to achieved, the main character had a personal interest in music. (3) Ambition based on Strong Desire had big dreams and a strong determination to achieved them. With a strong desire the individual began to pursue this opportunity Miguel Rivera had a strong desire to become a famous musician.

B. Suggestion

The writer realized that there were many types of ambition that could be found in the *Coco* movie script. Due to the writer had limitations in finding information and experience of the writer in writing this as a lacked of capacity in interpreting the data for analysed. The writer wanted to suggest future writers could used different theories from previous writers theories to examine literary works with the same movie script title. This supports future writers to dissect the same movie script. As the writer find out more what types were divided into the ambitions of every human being in this movie script and looked for what impacts. The writer also suggested that future writers could used the theory from Adler and Barsukova to research different movie script.

The writer hoped this research could be used as a referenced benefits as well as being a referenced for future writers this research could examine literary works and view the dialogue contained in the movie script and it could support sources that help the writer find this research data which taken as a reference in various sources such as books and journals.
